I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. These Regulations of the International European University (hereinafter – the University) define the general principles for awarding the title "Visiting Professor of International European University" (hereinafter – "Visiting Professor"). The title is intended to expand and strengthen the University's ties with leading scholars and educational institutions and to promote the University's achievements in accordance with Ukrainian legislation.

1.2. The awarding of the title "Visiting Professor" is carried out in accordance with the Development Strategy of the University and serves as official recognition of personal merit.

1.3. The official title in Ukrainian is " Visiting Professor of International European University"; in English – "Visiting Professor of International European University".

II. CRITERIA FOR AWARDING

2.1. The title "Visiting Professor" may be awarded to citizens of Ukraine or foreign states with significant pedagogical or research contributions who are not employees of the University but agree to contribute personally to the educational and scientific work of the University within the framework of international cooperation programs and agreements (grant, teaching, or research activities).

III. PROCEDURE FOR AWARDING

3.1. The decision to award the title "Visiting Professor" is made and enacted by the Rector's order, based on which a diploma of the title is issued.

3.2. The title is awarded for the period of scientific, teaching, or grant activity at the University.

3.3. Recommendations for candidacy may be submitted by Academic Councils of Educational and Scientific Institutes at the initiative of faculty or University administration.

3.4. The recommending body shall submit the following documents to the Vice-Rector for Academic and Scientific Work:

- Petition from the project team addressed to the Rector;
- Extract from the Academic Council meeting minutes recommending the candidate;
- Candidate's CV.

Upon review of the submitted documents, the Vice-Rector initiates a draft order.

IV. RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TITLE HOLDERS

4.1. Individuals awarded the title of 'Visiting Professor' have the right to:

- Participation in academic and methodological conferences and seminars;
- Involvement in the University's research and educational process;
- Participation in competitions for the best scientific works;
- Access to University libraries, labs, research and experimental facilities;
- Teaching classes for higher education students, interns, postgraduates, and doctoral students;
- Publishing academic and methodological works in University publications and serving as peer reviewers.

4.2. Individuals awarded the title of 'Visiting Professor' are obliged to:

- Ensure high-quality teaching aligned with academic or partner programs;
- Provide open access to classes online (unless otherwise stipulated);
- Adhere to academic integrity;
- Follow pedagogical ethics, respect for students and staff;
- Comply with Ukrainian laws, University Statute, internal regulations, and policies.

V. OTHER PROVISIONS

5.1. These Regulations are adopted by the Academic Council and enacted by the Rector's order.

5.2. Amendments and additions are made based on the decision of the Academic Council and take effect after the Rector's order.
