

Procedure
for organizing admission of foreigners and stateless persons to
International European University
in 2025

I. General provisions

1. Admission of foreigners and stateless persons to the University is carried out according to the Laws of Ukraine On Higher Education, On the Legal Status of Foreigners and Stateless Persons, On Legal Status of Foreign-Based Ukrainians, On Refugees and Persons in Need of Subsidiary Protection or Asylum, On Establishing Additional Legal and Social Guarantees for Citizens of the Republic of Poland Staying in the Territory of Ukraine; the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 729 dd. September 12, 2018, ‘Issues of Obtaining Higher Education By Certain Categories of Persons’; The Procedure for Organizing the Admission of Foreigners and Stateless Persons to Vocational, Professional Pre-Higher, and Higher Education Institutions of Ukraine, as well as Training (Internship) Using the Unified Interagency Information System of Ukraine for Foreigners and Stateless Persons Wishing to Study at Vocational, Professional Pre-Higher, and Higher Education Institutions of Ukraine approved by the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 758 dd. June 28, 2024; the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 1541 dd. November 1, 2013, ‘Some Issues of the Recruitment and Training (Internship) of Foreigners and Stateless Persons’ registered at the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on November 25, 2013, under No. 2004/24536; the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No. 1498 dd. December 2, 2019, ‘On Approval of the Procedure for Establishing Quotas for Receiving Higher Education by Foreigners and Stateless Persons Within the State Order in Accordance with International Treaties of Ukraine’ registered at the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on February 10, 2020, No. 153/34436.

Citizens of the Russian Federation, the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Republic of Belarus, and the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea who do not have a permanent residence permit in Ukraine are admitted to study by individual permission of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

2. Foreigners and stateless persons, stateless persons who have applied for refugee status, persons who have applied for protection in Ukraine and are documented by certificates of application for protection in Ukraine (hereinafter referred to as foreigners) can obtain higher education at the expense of individual and/or legal entities, unless otherwise provided by international agreements of Ukraine, the consent to be bound by the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine, laws or agreements between higher education institutions on international academic mobility.

Admission of foreigners and stateless persons, including foreign Ukrainians permanently residing in Ukraine, citizens of the Republic of Poland, persons recognized as refugees and persons in need of additional protection, to state-funded places is carried out in accordance with paragraph 6 of Section III of the 2025 Admission Procedure approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine No.168 dd. February 10, 2025, and registered at the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on February 26, 2025, under No. 15/41360.

Foreigners are admitted to receive higher education in accredited educational programs. International European University can also admit foreigners to programs of the preparatory faculty (department) to study the state language and/or language of instruction, as well as for postgraduate education, advanced training, and internships.

3. Foreigners can be admitted to study at the University in person and/or remotely. Admission of foreigners is carried out through the Unified Interagency Information System of Ukraine for Foreigners and Stateless Persons Wishing to Study at Vocational, Professional Pre-Higher, and Higher Education Institutions of Ukraine (hereinafter referred to as the Unified System).

The validity of an electronic invitation to study issued through the Unified System shall not exceed six months from the date on which it is affixed with the qualified electronic seal of International European University or the qualified electronic signature of the University's authorized person.

The invitation to study issued via the Electronic Log Automated System of the state enterprise authorized by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine remains valid until April 1, 2025, inclusive.

Foreigners who have received the electronic invitation to study, received a range of information and consulting support services (if the invitation was issued through the Electronic Log Automated System of the state enterprise authorized by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine), and have completed the procedure for legalizing their educational documents in the country of issue are eligible to take part in the remote admission: legalized documents at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the country that issued the document on education; legalized documents at the consular department of the diplomatic mission of Ukraine abroad (consular legalization or apostille).

In order to organize remote admission of foreigners to receive higher education and to study in programs of the preparatory faculty (department) to study the state language and/or language of instruction, as well as for postgraduate education, advanced training, and internships, International European University conducts identity verification and entrance examinations in a distance format with mandatory video recording (including screen recording of the applicant's device). The video recording of the entrance examination is stored by International European University within five years after the exam for foreigners is conducted, and a link to this recording is entered into the Unified Database.

In case of distance admission, a foreigner sends legalized and notarized copies of documents on previous education to International European University by post. When

crossing the state border of Ukraine for the first time and upon arrival at the University, the foreigner shall provide the original documents in person.

4. Enrollment of foreign applicants to study International European University at the expense of individuals and/or legal entities can be carried out:

1) twice per year within the deadlines stipulated in the Admission Rules for obtaining Bachelor's, Master's, PhD/Doctor of Arts degrees (internship):

- from February 1, 2025, to May 31, 2025;
- from August 1, 2025, to October 31, 2025;

2) within a year to study at the preparatory department (faculty).

International European University calculates points/grades of applicants based on the document on the previous educational level and sets the minimum amount of points/grades in general subjects for the entrance examination for foreigners.

Enrollment of foreigners to study for obtaining a corresponding level of higher education is based on the document on the previously acquired level of education due to the results of the entrance exam for foreigners in defined subjects and language of instruction, as well as on the grounds of academic rights to continue study provided by the document on the acquired educational level in the country of its origin and performance points that allow continuing study at the next level of higher education according to legislation of the country issuing the educational document.

5. All categories of foreigners are enrolled at International European University based on enrollment orders. This fact can be confirmed by the certificate formed in the Unified State Electronic Database on Education (USEDE).

6. The requirements of International European University for compliance of foreign applicants who have arrived in Ukraine to study with the Admission Procedure and Rules, as well as the deadlines for accepting applications and documents, conducting the entrance exam for foreigners and enrollment are specified in the Admission Rules and published on the official website of International European University.

7. Foreigners provided with state scholarships according to international agreements, nationwide programs, and other international obligations of Ukraine are enrolled within stipulated quotas for foreigners on the grounds of orders of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

8. Foreigners arriving in Ukraine to participate in the academic mobility programs or to obtain higher education according to educational programs approved by Ukrainian and foreign higher education institutions are enrolled given the corresponding contractual obligations of corresponding higher education institutions.

9. Foreigners and stateless persons, including foreign Ukrainians permanently residing in Ukraine, persons recognized as refugees, and persons in need of additional protection, have the same rights to obtain education as citizens of Ukraine, in particular, at the expense of the state or local budget, with the exceptions established by the Constitution of Ukraine, the laws of Ukraine, or international treaties, the consent to be binding was provided by the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine.
