ENDORSED:

I. To take note of the information of the Director of the Department of Quality Assurance of Education of the International European University Drozdova A.V. on international accreditation.

- to continue active work on the collection and analysis of the necessary information for international accreditation;

- to expand the spheres and directions of internationalization of educational activities within the framework of the University's activities.

II Information of the Vice-Rector for Scientific and Educational and Methodological Work of the University Boyarko I. M. on the certification of postgraduate students should be taken into account.

- based on the results of the attestation, to recommend for transfer to the second year seven postgraduate students of the ESI "European School of Business" and four postgraduate students of the ESI "European Medical School", who have completed the curriculum in full.

III Information of the Vice-Rector for Administrative and Economic Affairs S. L. Zavoruev about the shelter of the International European University to take note.

- to determine the security issue as a priority and priority in the activities of the University;
- make changes to the deadlines for the delivery of shelter object No. 2;
- after the completion of the repair of the shelter, conduct a commission check of the technical condition of the premises and the compliance of the shelter with all regulatory requirements and prepare an act of readiness of the shelter for operation;
- introduce regular briefings and trainings at the university for students and staff on security and emergency response. Update evacuation plans, instructions, and routes for quick access to shelters on campus. Ensure the availability of all necessary protective equipment, medical kits and other resources that may be required in a crisis situation;
- organize psychological support for students and university staff through counseling with psychologists and access to support resources. Introduce the possibility of online consultations and assistance for persons who need psychological support in conditions of stress or uncertainty.
